ST IVES HOLIDAY HOMES - BOOKING CONDITIONS

(please read the following conditions carefully, then complete the attached booking form, print it out and either fax or post it to us)

BOOKING:

If the dates requested are available, we will mail you our official booking form which must be completed in full and returned promptly to confirm your reservation. Bookings made more than six weeks in advance require a 1/3 deposit. The balance is due six weeks before the holiday commences.

Bookings made less than six weeks in advance require payment in full at the time of booking.

We reserve the right to cancel your holiday through unforeseen circumstances.

METHOD OF PAYMENT:

Payment should be by cheque, payable to Mrs J M Harling.

ELIGIBILITY:

Bookings will not be accepted from:

- Groups of single persons under the age of 25 years.
- All male or all female parties in excess of two.

TIMES OF LETTING:

Lettings commence from 1500hrs (3pm) on the first day of tenancy and end at 1000hrs (10am) on the last day of the tenancy.

INSURANCE:

We strongly advise you to arrange cancellation insurance to cover the cost of your holiday.

THE TENNANT AGREES:

- To keep and leave the accommodation in a tidy state.
- To pay for any breakages or damage.
- Not to cause a nuisance to the neighbours.
- To allow the owner or his employees reasonable access.
